At the board meeting on Wednesday night, I presented the **2024 data report for reading, writing and mathematics**. It is very pleasing to see the upward trend of achievement has continued in 2024. Since 2021, in reading 13.5% more students achieved their expected curriculum level, 26% in writing and 22% in mathematics. These continued increases over 4 years in achievement do not happen by accident, and I want to congratulate the tamariki, teachers, and whānau for the learning partnership and commitment they make to grow outstanding tamariki. With all the new implementations we continue to put in place we believe the trend will continue for 2025.

I also want to thank everyone who contributed to our **annual swimming sports**. It has been a great day with our tamariki challenging themselves to be the best they can be. I look forward to the success the inter school team will have in Te Kuiti next week. A special thanks to Mrs Bailey and Miss Sicely for all their organisation.

Also on Thursday I met with our **house leaders**. It is my intention to meet with them once a fortnight to develop their leadership skills and hear their voices about some actions or projects we can be doing to make our kura even better. As our school leaders they are going to have the opportunity to lead some innovations. I am excited to see what ideas they have.

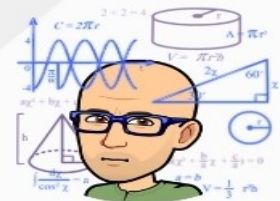


We have been learning:

- Algorithms



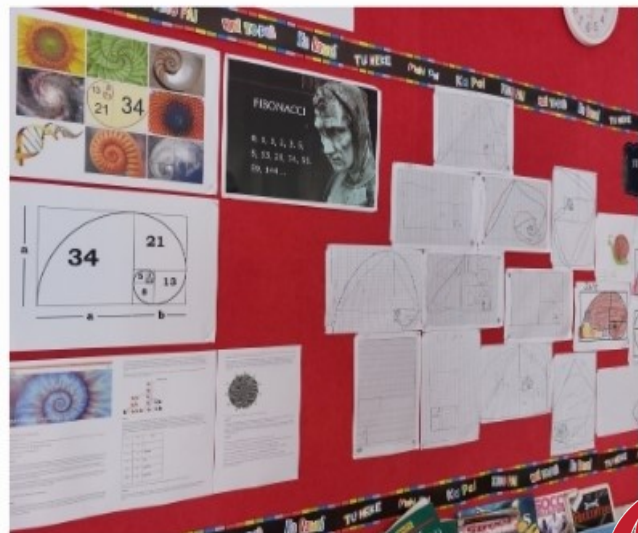
Our maths work is spiralling to infinity!
